What can help Downtown become more vibrant? How would you like to see Downtown improved?





Redesign Fayetteville Street and City Plaza to allow for more year-round activity




"Fayetteville's wide sidewalks are what sets it apart


However, the current design limits our ability to creatively use these wide sidewalks even for outdoor dining




Step 1: Remove to activate




5 Make downtown's major thoroughfares greener and more pedestrian-friendly

Make a physical connection between the Warehouse **District**, NC State's Main **Campus and** Centennial Campus




